Who qualifies for Allegheny County Older Youth Pandemic relief?

You can get cash assistance if you:

Have been in CYF placement in Allegheny County and dependent at age 14 or older.

Are currently at least 18, and not older than 26.

How to get the money:

Go to youthpgh.org.

Complete a quick application.

You can choose to get your money through PayPal or by check. It may take a week or two to verify your eligibility after you apply.

Allegheny Older Youth Pandemic Relief is funded by the federal government and managed collaboratively by the Allegheny County Department of Human Services, KidsVoice and ACTION-Housing.
